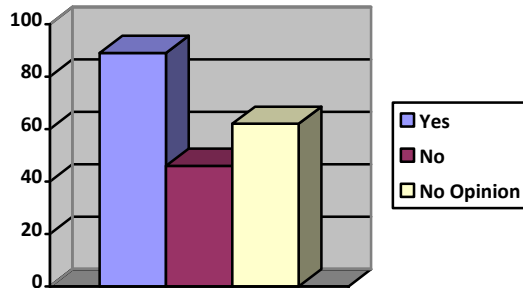


Comments: Is it used enough? More information re events needed.

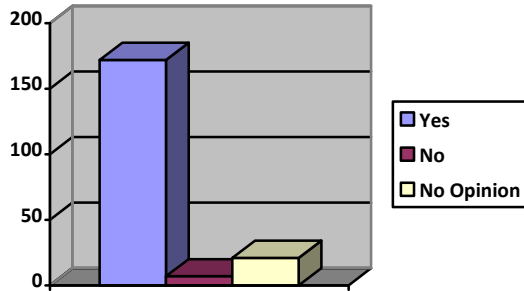
Comments:

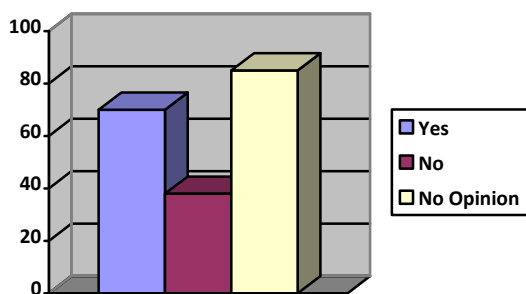

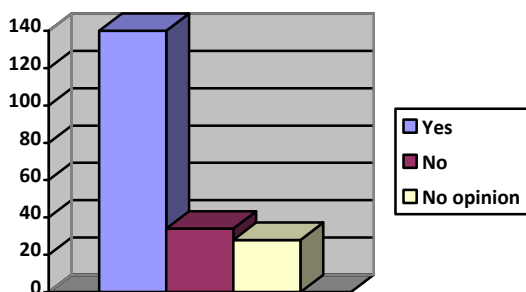
